Counseling Rule 338.1751a Rule 1a and Social Work 338.2929 Rule 29 Training standards for identifying victims of human trafficking; requirements.. (1) Pursuant to section 16148 of the code, MCL 333.16148, an individual licensed or seeking licensure shall complete training in identifying victims of human trafficking.

Dr. Jeremy S. Norwood, is currently an Associate Professor of Sociology, Global Studies, and Criminal Justice at Spring Arbor University in Spring Arbor, Michigan. His research focuses on three major areas of human trafficking: migrant farmworker populations in Western Michigan, massage parlors in South-Central Michigan, and on backpage, plus other adult advertisement sections which advertise all over Michigan. Dr. Norwood has also served as a part of task forces in Calhoun, Jackson, and Lenawee Counties.

From the North:

Take US 23 south to M-14 west. Take M-14 west to exit #2 Maple Miller Rd. At the end of the exit ramp is a stop sign. This is Maple Rd. Cross over Maple Rd. and continue Turn right or west on Miller. Turn left or south on Wagner Rd. After you pass Liberty Rd., You will see it on your left enter the second or southern-most driveway.

From the South:

Take US 23 north to I-94 west. Take I-94 west exit #175 Saline-Ann Arbor Rd. Turn right or north on Saline-Ann Arbor Rd. Travel about 1.5 miles to Scio Church Rd. Turn left or west on Scio Church Rd. Turn right or north on Wagner Rd. Washtenaw Intermediate School District is on the right, enter the first or southern-most driveway.

From the East:

Take I-94 west to exit #175 Saline-Ann Arbor Rd. Turn right or north on Saline-Ann Arbor Rd. Follow directions from South Travel about 1.5 miles to Scio Church Rd. Turn left or west on Scio Church Rd. Turn right or north on Wagner Rd. Washtenaw Intermediate School District is on the right, enter the first or southern-most driveway

From the West:

Take I-94 east to exit #169 Zeeb Rd. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right or south. Turn left or east on Liberty Rd. Turn right or south on Wagner Rd. Within about 1/2 mile you will see Washtenaw Intermediate School District on your left. You will see it on your left enter the second or southern-most driveway.
